DUST CONTROL APPLICATION – 2020 SEASON

Product Used: Magnesium Chloride

- **Application and payment must be received in our office by May 1st.**
- Specific application dates are based on when the County has prepared the roads and authorized us to begin spraying. Dates are subject to change and are impacted by weather. The first application occurs Mid-May through Mid-June. The second is approximately 60 days after the first application.
- Applicant agrees to maintain flags to mark outer limits of the area to be treated. **Flags must be in place May 1st until October 15th.** Failure to do this could result in the area being bladed. Neither the County nor Heffron Services assume any liability if your flags are not in place. If area is not marked, drivers will either center on your house or use their best judgment for location.
- Our trucks are equipped with computer equipment that allows us to spray the exact amount of footage ordered. If your flags are set longer than the footage paid for, your dust control will not reach both flags. If your flags are set shorter than the footage paid for, your dust control will extend past your flags.
- The county reserves the right to blade the treated area to maintain the public safety. Your road will be bladed after October 1st.
- Heffron Services, Inc. does not guarantee the performance of the product due to factors such as weather, surface preparation, gravel materials, heavy traffic patterns and maintenance of the roadway.
- **Include payment with this application.** We will cash your check after the first application, or May 15th whichever is earlier.

The application and maintenance of chemicals or other products on gravel surfaced roads to control dust shall be by permit only and in accordance with the following specifications and conditions:

The homeowner shall be responsible for clearly flagging their treatment area throughout the entire dust control season.

Dust control products may be applied only by an approved contractor Holding a valid permit and using a County Engineer approved product.

The application rate shall be determined by the contractor. Any or all claims for damages to vehicles as a result of the applied dust control product shall be borne by the person or persons applying the dust control product

The County Engineer's office shall be notified 5 working days in advance of the dust control product being applied so that the roadway may be properly shaped. This will also apply to any reapplication of dust control products in case any repair shaping is needed. The contractor shall provide a complete list of dust control application sites to Montgomery County Secondary Roads for use by the maintenance department to coordinate maintenance activities.

Montgomery County reserves the right to rework the treated area and maintain it as loose granular surface if the roadway surface becomes unacceptable to the County. The County Engineer's judgment shall be the sole determining factor on reworking treated areas to a loose granular surface. The county shall not be responsible for any costs associated with reapplication of dust control products if the area is not clearly marked or if reshaping is required to repair the treated area.

The work in right of way permit shall go into effect on May 1, 2020 and expire on October 1, 2020, so the treated area can be worked prior to winter.

The contractor's material, application rate, and performance shall be subject to applicant-contractor agreement.
